Dear Church Member,

Re: Granny's Attic, Collectables & Antiques Booth – 2007 Fall Festival

You may recall that in last year's Fall Festival we had our second "Collectables & Antiques Booth." Thanks to the individual items contributed by several members and significant contributions from individual estates we raised over \$1,500 for the Fall Festival over the past two years.

With last year's success, we plan to again have a "Collectables & Antiques Booth" in the 2007 Fall Festival and expand it to include some Granny's Attic items. For success again this year we will need your help.

- If you have any collectables, antiques, or attic items that need to find a new home – consider putting them in our booth at this year's Fall Festival.
- If you are planning an estate sale in the next several years – consider placing some of your collectable items and/or antiques in this year's booth.
- Also, this year we will take other attic items that are in good working order and have no damage.

Note: This booth is not a garage sale where anything will be sold – each item should be either something that is potentially collected by someone, is considered an antique, or is an item that is in good working order and has no damage.

Any antiques or collectable items you wish to place in the booth will be sold on a consignment basis with all the proceeds going to the Church. For higher priced antiques (over \$500) at least 50% of the proceeds must go to the church with the balance going to the donor. As the donor, you will be responsible for placing a sales price on each antique or collectable you donate. If the item does not sell within the price range that is acceptable to you, it will be returned to you following the Fall Festival. You will receive a receipt for tax purposes for each item that is sold. For all other attic items which are not sold, they will be sent to a charity organization.
